

The mystery of the missing emails



Thank you for letting us know about your emails going missing. It has been frustrating for the victims as well as the Wessex Appraisal investigative team. We have found the two main culprits: Firstly, responding directly to the FFARMS automated emails as replies will not reach us. Our suggested solution: instead of responding directly to the FFARMS email always ensure you forward to one of the Wessex team. Secondly, the spam folder has been abducting emails. As we check ours, please make sure to check yours regularly too! If you include our initials 'WAS' at the beginning of your subject line title, this is set to override the spam filter and will ensure your messages reach us.

Please report all emails that have gone unanswered for more than three working days as soon as you notice they are 'missing in action'. We will continue to use the WhatsApp group, or (especially if it is urgent) just pick up the phone: +44 7538 369444
